## **MESA COUNTY SEARCH & RESCUE HELP FIND TWO** **Two 8 year old boys wander off, get lost over night.**

Mesa County, Colorado—Last night at approximately 10:30 pm, Mesa County Search & Rescue, Inc., was called to the town of Mesa to begin a search for two lost boys. The eight year old friends had wandered away from home, by 1130, 21 SARC volunteers, friends and family members were in the field looking for the boys. At 2 A.M., dispatch sent out pre-recorded call to the residents of Mesa to be on the lookout for the two boys.

This morning SARC expanded the number of volunteers in the field to about 30, including the ATV team, posse, and more ground team members. The Colorado State Patrol assisted with their fixed wing aircraft, and the Colorado Division of Wildlife also assisted with an officer joining the search. MCSO Deputies also assisted in the search this morning going door-to-door, and asking people to check their property for the lost boys.

Around 9 A.M., two boys were spotted coming out of a barn. The land owners stopped the boys and confirmed they were the boys everyone was looking for. Both were in good condition, with no injuries.

The two boys had wandered off and then realized they could not find their way home and they spent the night in the barn. Both were reunited with their families.
